



Digital skills 50+ Questionner

Summary of questionnaires

The intention of this questionnaire is to explore demand and barriers of access for unemployed people to IT skills. The surveys were conducted in May-June 2017. The target group was unemployed people registered in district labor offices in age 50+.

The total number of respondents is 90 from four countries (Poland, The Netherlands, Czech Republic, Hungary). The questionnaire interviews were conducted face to face, in district labor offices or in community centers.








Do you have internet access at home?




What kind of tools do you use? (answers presented in%)




Where do you use a computer? (answers presented in%)




Why do you want to improve your skills? (answers presented in%)




What do you use computers for? (answers presented in%)




Have you ever looked for a job or sent a job application via Internet? (answers presented in%)



What kind of former experienc/studies do you have? (answers presented in%)






What do you like to learn? (answers presented in%)




What do you see as your main problem? (answers presented in%)






Age
